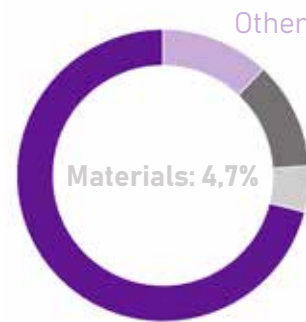
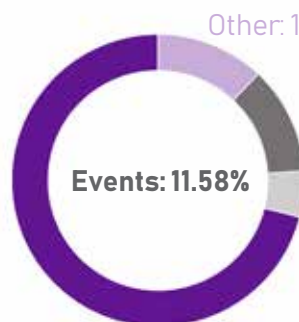
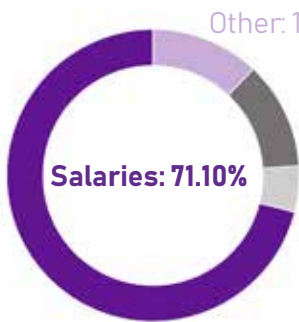
## Total donations

## Donor Disclosure

The Political Party Funding Act which regulates and aims to make the funding of political parties by private and public funders more transparent, does not currently make provision for independent candidates. Subsequently, the Independent Electoral Commission (IEC) is currently only accepting donor reporting data from political parties.

Based on the principles of transparency and accountability, Zackie2024 will hold itself to the same standard as political parties, therefore we are declaring our major donors (R100 000 or more) here, until the IEC reporting has been put in place.
